

## The Wolves of Isle Royale: Lessons from 50 Years of Research

Dr. Vucetich will discuss what he and his colleagues have learned from decades of field studies on the ecology of wolves and moose on Isle Royale in Lake Superior. This 50-year study provides important insights into the value of long-term research. John has published over 50 papers in top journals that have addressed a variety of topics that influence predatorprey dynamics, including behavioral ecology, foraging ecology, sociality, inbreeding, density-dependence, demographic stochasticity, nutrient cycling, senescence, disease, extinction risk, and policy/advocacy.
